


A Walk in London.



PSED and Religious Education

In the build up to Christmas, we will be learning about Christianity and advent. We will be discussing fire safety to ensure that we stay safe on Bonfire Night and Guy Fawkes will be helping the children to stay safe online.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be using lots of different mediums in our art work this term. The children will design and make houses from Pudding Lane at the time of the Fire of London as well as different London landmarks. They will be using different techniques to create firework art, using paint, chalk and lots of glitter. The children will be learning to evaluate, show preferences and make changes to their work. And of course we will be doing lots of singing with Mary Poppins!

Mathematics and Computing

This term we will be focusing on multiplication and division in maths, using concrete, pictorial and mental methods. We will have a chance to practice our measuring skills and make some of our own landmarks using cm. We will be designing our own mathematical questions and using tally charts, pictograms and block graphs to represent the data we collect. At the end of the term we will be using money in role as Londoners to buy and sell goods.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

This half term we will be taking a walk through the London past and present. We will begin by looking at The Gunpowder Plot and work our way to present day via The Great Fire of London and the Suffragette movement in the early 1900s. We will be using our Geography skills to look at maps, including the London underground and city of London, including lots of famous landmarks on the way. We will find out about different transport, including the famous London double decker bus. And of course Mary Poppins will help us all along the way!

Literacy

We will be using our literacy skills to learn about lots of different aspects of London through time. We will be writing diaries in role as some of the characters from the Great Fire of London; writing information pages about London and parents will be receiving some written invitations for our London Exhibition.

Phonics, Guided Reading and SPAG sessions will continue throughout the term.

Physical Education

PE will take place on the day allocated to your class last term. We will be exploring rhythm, control and movement through dance. On Monday afternoons, the children will also be taking part in Capoeira with an outside instructor.
