What's Your Superpower?

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be discussing the three golden reminders with the children and talking about how they can be a good role model. We will also begin to adopt a growth mindset which will allow us to become super learners and share our aspirations for the future! We will get better at forming positive relationship with others.

Literacy

This term the children will be working on Phase 2 of Letters and sounds, focusing on the initial sounds in words. We will read a range of stories linked to our superheroes.

The children will be encouraged to mark-make using a range of tools and materials.

Understanding the World

We will be talking about family and friendships and we will invite children to share their holiday news. We will begin to talk about why things happen and how things work. The children will use technology to support their learning.

Communication and Language

We will be reading lots of stories that focus on superheroes. As part of our work on the Golden Reminders we will be getting better at following instructions straight away. In our imaginative play we will use talk to pretend that objects are something else.

Physical Development

We will be focusing on strengthening our fine motor skills this term which will help us to use one-handed tools effectively. The children will be encouraged to become more independent in their self-care. Outside, the children will have the opportunity to build and complete a superhero obstacle course.



Mathematics

Our main focus this topic will be counting objects one-to-one and getting better at recognising numbers. We will cover positional language.



Expressive Arts and Design

We will be getting creative with this theme and the children will help us to create our very own 'Superhero City' role play area. They will also use resources to create props for their imaginative play.
