



Expressive Arts and Design

To start the topic, we will be creating our role play areas; using the children's ideas as a stimulus. They will have the opportunity to experiment with papier mache and plan, design and evaluate their own rockets. We will be listening to and creating our own planet compositions.

Understanding the World

This term we will be using the book 'The Man on the Moon' as our inspiration for our Space theme. The children will be researching and presenting information about the moon landing and the planets in the solar system. We will be comparing different materials when designing and making rockets.

PSED and R.E.

As Year Twos, the children will need to consider their roles and responsibilities within our school. They will be looking at what makes a good role model and many of them will get the chance to be a Green Team member. We will be talking about our aspirations for the following year and our future selves. To finish off the topic, we will be encouraging the children to think about environmental issues and how we can help our planet.

P.E.

Over the next term the children will be taking part in Dance and Games lessons. They will experiment with different ways of moving and begin to understand tactics of different invasion games.

Mathematics and Computing

In Maths this term, we will be concentrating on the children's understanding of number including place value and number sequences. When creating futuristic models, the children will be encouraged to describe the properties of 2 and 3D shapes.

In the coming weeks, the children will have the opportunity to control different digital toys such as the Beebots.

Literacy

We will be reading the book the 'Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartrum. Using this as a stimulus, the children will take part in Drama activities to inspire their writing which will take the form of postcards, letters and stories. We will be concentrating on their use of punctuation including their use of capital letters and full stops.

Communication and Language

The children will be participating in discussions, presentations, performances and role play to help their oral and written work. They will be developing their speaking and listening skills in order to become more confident public speakers.
