

### Physical Development

This term in physical development we will be developing our dance skills. Each class will choose a song and put together dance moves to create a class dance. Furthermore, in games we will be working on ball skills including throwing and catching, ball control as well as taking part in team games.

### Expressive Arts and Design

This term, the children will be exploring a variety of art, looking closely at how art differs among cultures and countries. We will explore different techniques to create our own piece of art work inspired by artists as well as our own ideas and imagination. We will begin to use the knowledge we gain of different art, cultures and traditions to learn new songs and dances that will shape our understanding of how people express themselves across the world. We will also be focussing on talking and listening to each other in order to share ideas and learn more from one another.

### PSED and Religious Education

This term we will learn about different religions through art and explore a range of religious stories and styles of worship. The children will continue to develop an understanding of themselves and others, build relationships and develop empathy for one another through a range of team building games and group learning experiences.

### Mathematics and Computing

In maths this term we will be mastering numbers to 100. This will include adding and subtracting numbers within 100 and using objects and pictorial representations to solve one and two step problems. Furthermore this term we will be exploring money. We will learn to recognise and name all coins and notes and begin to add and subtract with money.

### Communication, Language and Literacy

As we learn more about traditions and cultures around the world the children will have the opportunity to listen to poems and retell them to each other. The children will have the opportunity to create non-fiction books to share what they are interested in. During drama lessons and in role play the children will have the opportunity to act out scenes from stories, and rehearse narratives.

### Understanding the World

This term we will be exploring the four seasons, looking closely at the associated weather for each season. Furthermore, we will be exploring landscapes and locating the human and physical features. In addition, we will experiment with everyday materials, identify and naming them as well as describing some of their physical properties. We will also rec-cap our knowledge of the world's 7 continents locating them on a map and a globe.
