Summer Safety



When it is hot the children are reminded to . . .



Slip on a sun hat with a brim



Slop on sun-cream (SF 30+)



Slurp on some water through the day

- Children have access to water all day at school but may bring a named water bottle if they wish.
- Children may bring in named sun-cream. Spray sun-cream is easier for children to manage and avoids them putting on too much.
- Children must wear sandals or shoes to school rather than flip-flops, crocs or beach shoes as these are very dangerous when children are running and playing in the playground.
- Please make sure that children wear tops that keep their shoulders covered as they can burn very easily.
- Please do not send sunglasses into school as these are easily lost or broken and can be dangerous if a child falls over in the playground.
