When it is hot the children are reminded to . . .

Slop on sun-cream (SF 30+)



Slurp on some water through the day

- Children should bring a named water bottle every day and will be encouraged to drink and refill regularly.
Bottles should only contain water.
- Children may bring in named sun-cream.
- Children must wear sandals or shoes to school rather than flip-flops, crocs or beach shoes as these are very dangerous when children are running and playing in the playground.
- Please make sure that children wear tops that keep their shoulders covered as they can burn very easily.
 - Please do not send sunglasses into school as these are easily lost or broken
