Registration Time!

We appreciate that there are occasional times when being late for school is unavoidable however, we still have a number of children arriving late each morning. Please remember that children need to be in class ready for the register to be taken at 8.55am.

If your child arrives late, you need to ensure that they are registered at the school office so that we know they are here and can make sure they have a lunch ordered. Unfortunately, if a child is late for school, Parents/Carers are unable to take their child to class as this is disruptive for the children whose learning has already started. The only exception will be for children where an individual arrangement has been made in view of their special needs.

Please help us to make your child's morning routine a calm and happy one by ensuring they are here on time. If you need any advice or support regarding this, please speak with Mrs Prior (our Senior Parent Support Adviser) and she will be happy to help you.

Lost Property

The children are looking very smart in their school uniform. Please remember to ensure that all clothing, book bags, lunch boxes and any other items brought to school are clearly labelled.

Parent's Group

The parent's group meet every Tuesday between 9am-11am in the Green Room and Lionwood Infant School. If you would like to meet other parents and get involved we would love to see you!

Attendance

There is a clear link between your child's attendance at school and their levels of achievement so it is important that they are in school regularly. Here are some easy to remember guidelines.

High temperature

If your child has a raised temperature they should stay off school. Once their temperature is normal they can return to school the next day if there are no other symptoms of concern.

Vomiting and Diarrhoea

Your child should not return to school until they have been free of symptoms for 48 hours.

Cough, minor cold or sore throat

If your child appears to be coughing or complains of a sore throat but has no other symptoms they are probably fine to come to school. If you are unsure if your child is well enough to come to school please bring them in. If they develop a raised temperature or we have concerns that they are too unwell to remain in school, we will contact you.

When leaving a message of the absence line please ensure you give a specific reason for their absence. In the event of the given reason being 'unwell' or 'not coming into school today' it is necessary for us to contact you by phone for more information.

After School Clubs

Letters about this term's clubs will be coming home this week. Places are limited and will be randomly allocated by school. Please refer to the club letter for more information.

Road Safety

Road Safety outside the school remains a concern.

It is important that it is safe for our children and families to cross the road so please refrain from parking or reversing on the zig zag lines outside the school, or blocking the road and/or school car park entrance, to drop off children. Please also note that the car park is for staff only.

Also, please make sure that children are safely strapped into suitable safety seats when they are being driven to and from school.
