QUESTIONNAIRE



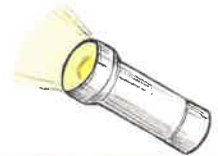
At the end of last half term we sent a questionnaire to parents to get your opinions about Lionwood Junior School. Overall the results were very positive:
